Practise	Children to practise saying the word. Say in a silly voice, loud voice, quiet voice etc. Tricky word bingo (Adult to say the word and the child has to find it)	Circle all the words that end with 'lp' or 'lk' Roll and Read Roll a die (no die - say a number) read the word next to that number and then tick it once read. Keep going until most/all are read.	Sorting activity Sort the pictures into two groups 'lf' and 'nt'	Model writing a sentence about the zoo. Remember – capital letter finger spaces and full stop. Make a mistake and see if they can spot the mistake and correct it.	What do we need to make a 'good' sentence? Read some silly sentences and correct them to make sense.
Apply	Children to practise writing the word. Challenge: To write a sentence including the tricky word 'are'.	Write dictated words – gulp and milk Write dictated sentence: Do not gulp the milk. Challenge – Think and write own sentence.	Read the letter. Can you find the 'lf' and 'nt' words? Challenge – Think and write own sentence.	Children to use lined paper to write their own sentence about visiting the zoo. Challenge – Include 'and' or 'because'	Cut out the sentence. Children to put the sentence back together. Challenge – create your own sentences to cut up and order.
